This year, for the first time, we will welcome girl campers from 8 to 12 to Foley where they will be able to partake in and enjoy all of the benefits that our boys have enjoyed during the past 49 years. There will be, as always, a strong emphasis on water activities, swimming, sailing, water skiing, and canoeing -- plus all the other Foley favorites of archery, riflery, shop (of course, girls, you can do it!) and camping trips -- plus special programs and activities that may appeal to girls only.



The girls' section of camp will be to the west of the chapel. They will have a separate dining area and separate program schedules -- in effect, we will have two separate camps on the same camp-grounds.

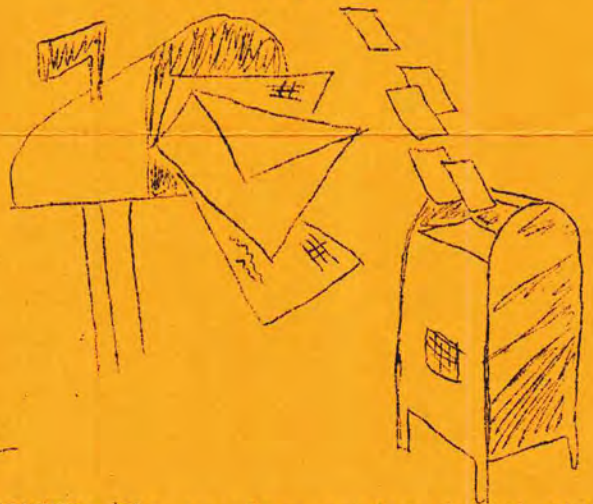
## STAFF NEWS
