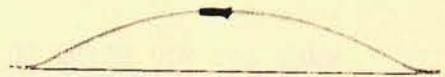

Foley needs soccer players for games against other camps. Rumor has it that the girl's soccer team will defeat the boy's team.

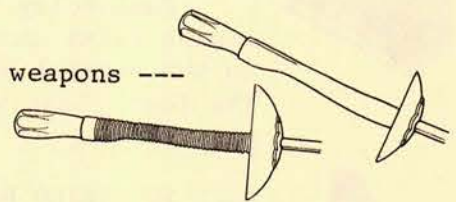

SAIL TRIP LAKE SUPERIOR - APOSTLE ISLAND

FOR GIRLS

There are still a few spaces available in both the boys and girls sail trips. This is your chance to experience the excitement of Lake Superior and the Apostle Islands. Learn the basics of large yachts with competent, certified instructors. The yachts (one for the boys and one for the girls) are 38 feet and 40 feet respectively and have all the accommodations necessary for a comfortable, safe cruise. You must be 14 years old and enjoy sailing. The cost is only \$200.00 which includes everything - food, transportation, etc. It could be the most fun you have ever had. FIRST B.W.C.A. TRIP FOR GIRLS

If you are a young lady fourteen years and older, don't miss this chance to experience the beauty of the Boundary Waters Canoe Area!
